(the "Underigned") for itself and on behalf of its
employees, agents, consultants and all similar persons or entities, intending to be legally bound hereby,
agrees that, with respect to the Confidential Information (as defined below) made available to Undersigned

Such remedies, however, shall not be deemed to be the exclusive remedies for any breach of this Agreement but shall be in addition to all other remedies available at law or in equity. This Agreement shall remain in effect for a period of one (1) year following completion of the Auction and shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania without regard to the conflicts of laws principles thereof. Any action to enforce the terms of this Agreement may be brought in the Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.
